LONDON PUBLIC SERVICE CHESS LEAGUE

PRIVACY POLICY STATEMENT

GENERAL

The London Public Service Chess League (LPSCL) is committed to protecting and respecting the privacy of all who participate in the League. This policy statement sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect or that you provide to us and is processed by the League. The data controller is the London Public Service Chess League.

INFORMATION COLLECTED

We collect personal information, including contact details about team captains and Club representatives, for the purposes intra-league communications. Any data held about outgoing captains or representatives is deleted.

The LPSCL has a legitimate interest in collecting data for the League to function effectively. Data is provided by Clubs who participate in the League and Cup competitions. This is in the form of the results of chess matches played between teams and provided by team captains or representatives using on-line forms. The information includes the name of every player participating in a match and the results from individual games. This information is publicly available on the LPSCL website. Results and final league tables are archived for historical purposes.

INFORMATION FROM OTHER SOURCES

The LPSCL uses information about players from other sources, namely from the English Chess Federation's (ECF) Grading Database. This will include each player's ECF membership status and their chess grading, which will be combined with published result forms. Information will be

used to assess any changes incurred against Clubs for playing non-ECF members.

PERSONAL DATA

We collect personal information, including contact details about team captains and Club representatives for the purposes intra-league communications. Any data held about outgoing captains or representatives is deleted.

COOKIES

Our website does not use cookies.

USES FOR THE INFORMATION

Personal information about Club representatives and team captains will be used by the LPSCL to contact Clubs about league and chess related matters. It will not be shared with third parties or used to circulate any non-chess related materials.

Match result information will appear on the LPSCL website and be used to make League tables. This information will be shared with the English Chess Federation and contributes to the national grading database and to assess any charges incurred by Clubs.

WHERE PERSONAL DATA IS STORED

All contact information provided to us by individuals for the purpose of the day-to-day functions of the League will be stored on the League website and available to all visitors. Individuals are responsible for keeping their information up-to-date.

For the purposes of submitting results and updating personal information, captains and club representatives have a user name and password, which they are responsible for keeping safe. The LPSCL asks that passwords are not shared.

INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS

Players have the right to ask the LPSCL not to process their personal data. However, in those circumstances it would not be possible for that individual to participate in any LPSCL activities.
